Have your photographer arrive in the morning if you want shots of you, your entourage, your partner and their entourage getting ready. They don't need to come for the entire time because no one wants photos halfway through the process! It just looks silly. *Try scheduling them for the last 1-2 hours of you getting ready.* That generally gives enough time for the following shots...

- Accessories details
- Dress details
- Vow books
- Final makeup touches (lipstick, mascara, etc)
- Final hair touches (placement of accessories, view, etc)
- Candid shots of party
- Lacing, buttoning, or zipping up the dress.
- First look: mom, grandma, party, dad
- Special poses in special getting ready attire (robs, button-up, etc)



### THE COUPLE


- First look
- Gift exchange
- Romantic portraits
- Rings on
- PDA shots (this is the time!)
- Special attire details
- Spinning in the dress
- Lifting Bride/Spinning
- Special poses (personalize it!)

I once heard from a photographer to make sure and squeeze 30 mins in your reception to hold a sunset photo session. It give you a chance to take in the day as a couple, alone. How romantic?! Highly recommend!




## WEDDING PARTY

- Bride with their party
- Groom with their party
- Couple + both parties
- Couple, ring bearer + flower girl
- Bride + flower girl
- Groom + ring bearer
- Bride with each member of their party
- Groom with each member of their party
- Bouquet/ring detail shot
- Boutonnière/tie/ring detail shot
- Bride + party special poses (funny, silly, shoes, etc)
- Groom + party special poses (funny, silly, shoes, socks, etc)
- Couple with specific party members on either side (such as siblings, grandparents, parents, generational)



## CEREMONY

- Seating of the front rows (parents/grandparents)
- Processional
- Couple's reaction to each other
- Officiant (especially if family/friend)
- Behind couple looking into guests (a personal fav)
- Vows and reactions from the couple
- Emotions of parents/grandparents during ceremony
- Emotions of wedding party during ceremony
- Exchanging of the rings
- Unity ceremony
- THE KISS... obviously
- Recessional



### RECEPTION

- Grand entrance
- Speeches/prayers
- Guests at tables (especially of reserved seating tables)
- Guests dancing!
- Cake cutting
- Kitchen staff (if family/friends)
- Grand exit (try to plan a fake one earlier for better shots and so that the photographer is still present!) Don't forget to be earth conscious!
- Mother/son dance
- Father/daughter dance
- Special parent dances
- Wedding party table/Sweetheart table
- (Squeeze in that sunset shoot now...)
